






In a survey conducted in Mumbai in 2019, 31% of surveyed women reported commuting as a barrier to working.

Frequency and waiting time Crew behaviour Visibility of last mile travel




It's Challenging To Travel as a Woman

- When it's overcrowded
- Bus stops are secluded, dark
- Low frequency of buses at nights
- Absence of crime-prevention mechanisms in buses
- Infrastructure is not designed for us



We are doing our bit for Inclusive Mobility

Making it Safer and Cost-Effective



- Live Tracking
- Bus Crowd Indicator
- SOS Share trip with family
- CCTV inside buses live monitoring
- Trained crew
- Trip-based plans to address multiple hops

Hiring Women in Work-force in Buses



- As Digital assistants / conductors
- Mandatory 20% women in field force
- Hiring women as our leaders

30% Women in Field Work Force



We currently have 20% women working as digital assistants in our buses



We are also setting up crew-training programmes for female drivers
