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Cities Today: Mobility Crisis



- Severe congestion
- Conflict between multiple modes
- Average speeds < 10 km/hr in most areas

Cities Today: Health Crisis



- 300 million people die every year due to the adverse effects of the air we breathe: WHO 2002

Cities Today: Safety Crisis



- 1000 accidents, 400+ deaths
- Most victims are pedestrians, cyclists, 2-wheeler riders

About 1.3 million people die each year on the world's roads and between 20 and 50 million sustain non-fatal injuries. Road traffic injuries are the leading cause of death among young people, aged between 15 and 29.

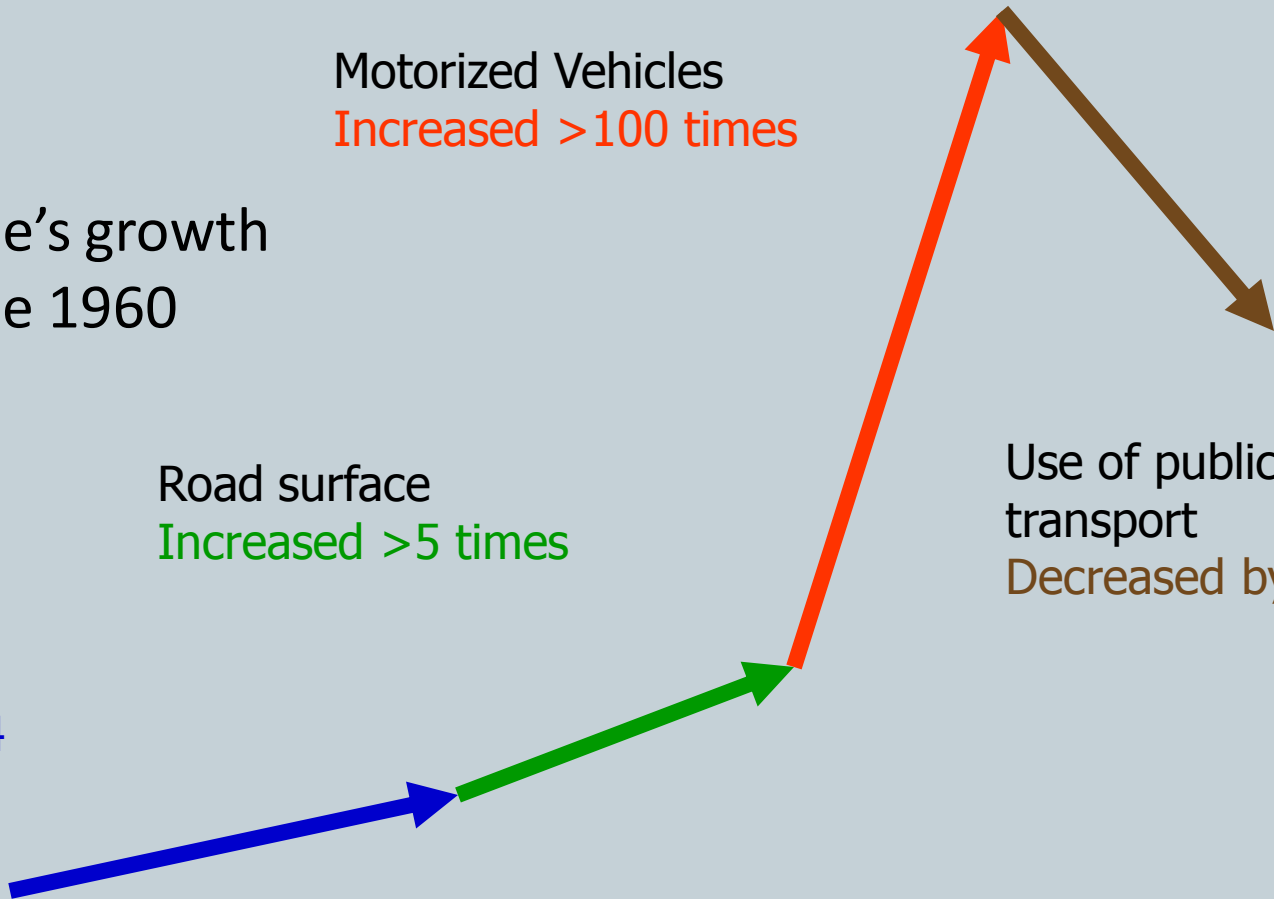

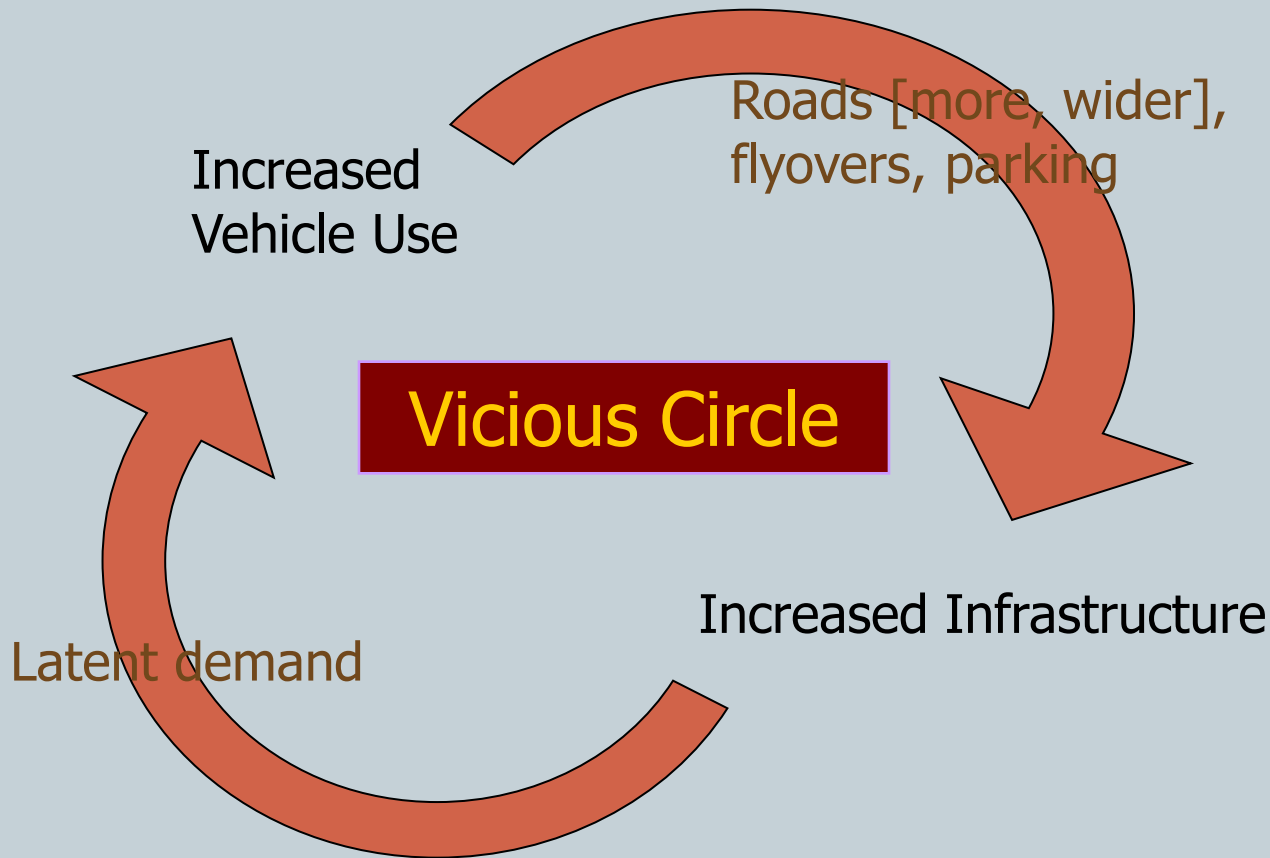

No free parking

Implementing the Parking Policy

Public support

Highlight the benefits

- Clearly marked spaces / signages
- Information
- More efficient use of existing parking spaces
- Reduction of impediment to moving traffic
- Reduction of encroachment onto pedestrian spaces
- Revenue for local area improvement
- Reduce conflict
- Protect residential parking from spill over

Technical expertise

Agencies for parking management

Contracts

Fixed revenue from contracting agency

- Simple
- No need for monitoring
- Don't get full value
- Can't change rates once contract issued

Fixed payment to contracting agency

- ULB gets full value
- Needs monitoring (use of technology)
- Immune to rates

Contracts

Data --- most valuable!

Maintenance of facilities - Information / signage

Assistance for enforcement

Grievance redress – by agency – escalation to ULB
