



WOULD COVID IMPACT YOUR MOBILITY CHOICES?




CHANGE IN MOBILITY PREFERENCE PRE AND POST-COVID






SHIFT TO ONLINE MODES

Did you switch to online modes for certain services, such as bill payments, banking?




Would you go back to accessing these services offline?






PERCEPTION OF VARIOUS TRANSPORT MODES




IS IT PERMANENT?
