The National Urban Transport Policy of the Government of India, 2006 (NUTP), inter-alia, lays strong emphasis on building capabilities at the state and city level to address problems associated with urban transport and lays down the guidelines for developing sustainable urban transport systems as well. As part of NUTP enunciations, the Ministry of Urban Development, Government of India has taken two important steps to develop capacity of the officials in the cities for improving the urban Mobility.

- Organizing an Annual Conference-cum-Exhibition on 'Urban Mobility' every year under the brand Urban Mobility India (UMI) for dissemination of information and to facilitate exchange of ideas;
- According recognition to good urban transport initiatives taken by cities / other agencies by giving awards to selected good practice projects.

So far eighth editions of *Urban Mobility India* have been organized around important themes as under:
